BATON ROUGE, La. – Members of the Postsecondary Education Review Commission will meet Monday, September 28 and continue through Tuesday, September 29, 2009 in House Committee Room 1 of the Louisiana State Capitol beginning at 8:00 a.m. both days. The topic for the meetings will be *Access, Success and Cost Reduction* focusing specifically on the issue of Louisiana's enrollment mix among its 2-year and 4-year universities.
